
Shout outs:

The school blog has blown me away this week! We've had exciting fieldwork in Y1 and Y2, beautiful writing in Y4, Y5 have been rocking their music lessons and also enjoyed being biologists looking at the functions of the heart!

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Expedition:

Another busy week has seen our children immersing themselves further in our current expeditions. EYFS have been busy designing postcards and have also had a visit from Mr Dan who performed a Punch and Judy show. KS1 took part in important field work, visiting Weston Park in Sheffield. Throughout the day they looked at maps of Sheffield and England, touched and played with artefacts/ tous and studied different periods in history. In Y3/4, children have continued to learn about slavery and how this links to the sugar trade. This week the children wrote emotive diary entries based on the experiences of Mary Prince. Y5 have begun their second case study of science. They have learnt about the circulatory system and its role in keeping the human body alive. They then moved onto becoming authentic scientists by dissecting a real heart to make connections to their theoretical studies. This experience has deepened their knowledge and understanding of how the heart is structured and how it works. For more information, why not check out our expedition sites?
