I feel blessed to work with such a fantastic Crew of adults and children!

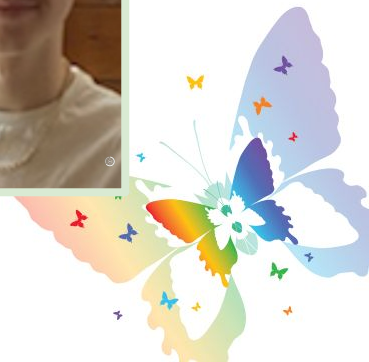
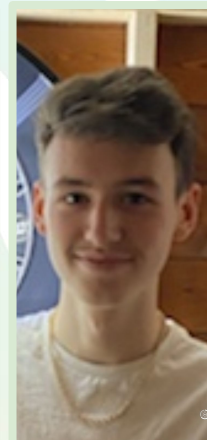


Learning Coach - Mr Michael Overson
