


## Shout outs:

# Expedition:

In **EYFS** this week the children have been rehearsing their performance and have recorded their song, performance and rap of the story of Goldilocks and the 3 bears! I can't wait to see this shared at our celebration of learning in such a special way!

In **key stage 1** we have been writing our final touchdowns, which have just blown all staff away. The effort that they have been putting in is amazing and it is clear that lots of progress has been made!

## Crew:

In crew this week **EYFS** have been thinking about friendship. We sorted sentences to think about what characteristics make a good friend and thought carefully about how we can be a good friend too.

In crew **key stage 1** have been thinking about what makes you a good friend and we had some great discussions about our own friendships.





In **Year 3/4** we have also been writing our final touchdowns which have been biographies on people who grew up during WW2. The children have put so much effort in and were really enthusiastic to learn more about each of our war experts. There has been lots of great writing and I know the teachers are really excited to read through them all!

In **year 5 and 6** this week, we have completed our scientific reports linked to forces. The children have worked hard to ensure they used scientific vocabulary and clearly explained the concepts that they have developed through the scientific investigations they carried out. This work is now being shaped into slides to support our product- the science lecture at Trinity Academy. To cap off a busy week, we have even had a go at using Scratch to code a model of our scientific investigations.

**Year 3/4** have continued to prepare for their SLCs by looking dt beautiful work that they are proud of. We have also looked at what makes a good friend and what a positive relationship looks like. We were also excited to celebrate anti-bullying week as well as Children in Need this week! It has been a busy week for crew!

In **year 5 and 6** we have used academic crew sessions to start our preparations for our Student Led Conferences which will take place in January. We have found examples of work in our books that we are proud of; we unpicked this in the form of self critique.
