Where possible we will have food surplus and a uniform bank. Pop in for a coffee and to see what we have available.

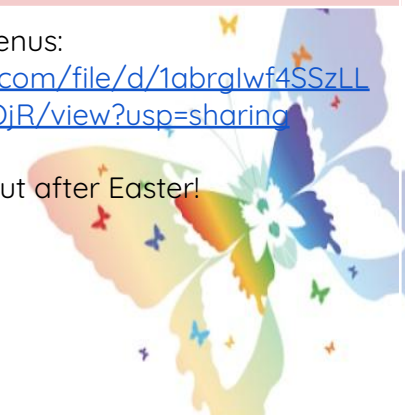

Reminders:
