In Year 1 we have started our new case study, which is all about Mae Jemison! We have learnt about space and shared some fantastic home learning that has taken place.

In year 2 we have been focusing on our year 2 assessments and our teachers are so proud of how hard we have all worked and tried our very best...we are looking forward to our treat on Friday!

In Year 3/4 this week, we have completed Case Study 1 and finished our geography work on volcanoes and earthquakes. We have also written our final touchdowns which were newspaper reports on the disaster of Pompeii. It's safe to say that all of the teachers were impressed with the standard of writing!

In Y5 this week, we have been continuing with our history case study. We have looked at how it would feel to be a child working in the mines. We have used a range of primary sources to investigate the Trimdon Grange Mining Disaster and have created a timeline to show the developments of safety equipment used to detect poisonous gases.

In Y6 we have started to focus on 'Final Word'. We have begun to reflect on our primary school journey and our highlights of our time at Green Top. We realised that we had many fond memories and have been able to experience many different things during our time here. We are looking forward to writing our final reflections in preparation for our presentation to a small audience.

In key stage 1 this week, our crew sessions have focused on being kind to others and saying sorry and the impact that this has on relationships. We used an example from women's football where a player was upset for getting a red card and made a public apology to everyone for hurting another player on the opposite team. What a great example set for our children.

In Year Y3/4 this week we had lots to celebrate in our community crew meeting. We have also been working really hard on our times tables in Y4 ready for our multiplication check after half term!

In year 5, we have talked about our highlights of this term. In community crew, we continued our work on healthy lifestyles and researched what happens if you don't have a healthy lifestyle. This week in Y6 crews, we worked in pairs and read our finished pieces of writing. We wrote postcards to each other, appreciating the elements that were successful.
