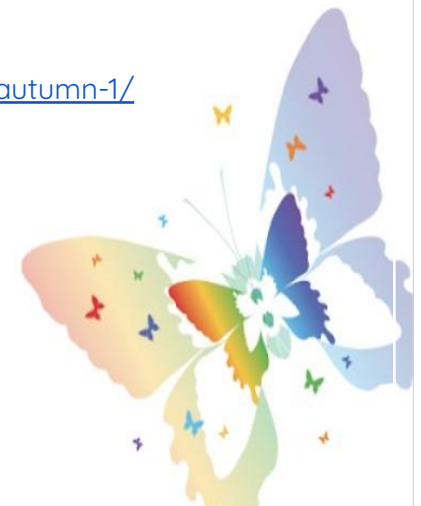

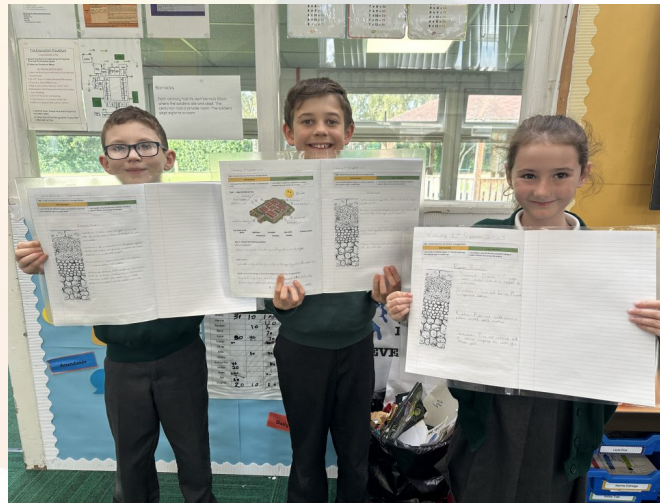

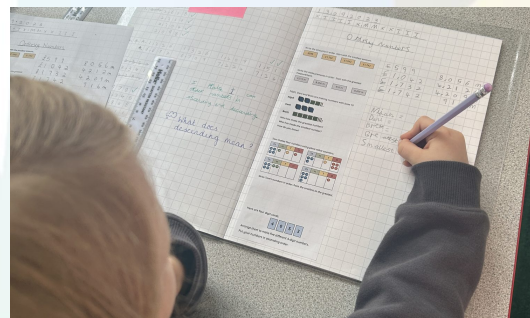

## Academic Success

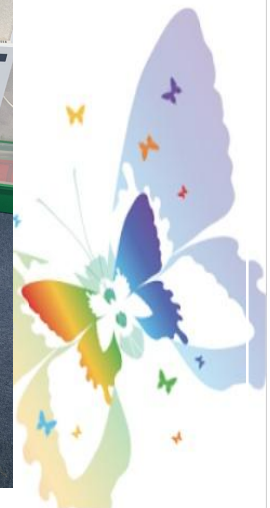
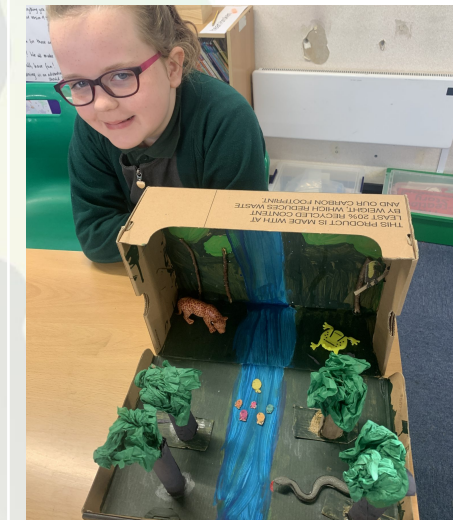

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## Expedition:

EYFS- This week the children have thoroughly enjoyed hooking into their new expedition 'Exploring our World'. The children are already beginning to answer the question 'What do stories tell us about Autumn?' and have immersed themselves into lots of crafting ready to decorate their classrooms! Reception children had the wonderful fieldwork visit to Sherwood pines and the Gruffalo trail was a firm favourite!

Y3/4 - What a fantastic week we've had in Y3/4! We have started delving deeper into the world of Romans and learnt all about Roman roads and why they were so beneficial. We also enjoyed making edible roads out of chocolate and biscuits! Year 3/4 were also lucky enough to have a Roman workshop where we learnt how to march like a soldier and use the different battle formations. We also used wax tablets and learnt more about aqueducts which will help us in our learning next week.

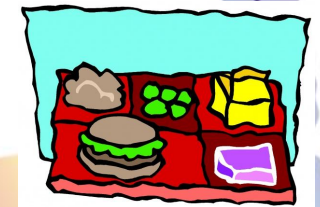
