

Y3/4: This week in expedition, Year 3/4 have continued to develop their knowledge of Romans and their inventions. We have moved on from looking at roads to the invention of aqueducts. We also enjoyed our field trip to Murton Park where we spent the day in a Roman fort reenacting marching and battle tactics!

Y5/6: This week has seen us delve deeper into our Geography case study to discover more about South America and the country of Brazil. We looked at Brazil's human and physical characteristics to understand why certain places were more populated than others. We came to the conclusion that the rainforest biome had a heavy influence on this.
