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Expedition:	Character Growth (Crew):
EYFS have had a fantastic week exploring the story 'Owl babies' following our expert visit to school by 'The yorkshire Owl Experience.' The children have created wonderful art thinking carefully about specific vocabulary and descriptive language used in the story.	EYFS have focused on family and friends this week. They have been showcasing their 'be kind' HoWLs and are well versed in their crew norms!
KS1 have had some great visitors this week. The drone police came in as well as the police van and car, which the children got to investigate and explore. They were in awe and wonder and had a fantastic afternoon.	Y3/4 enjoyed our second Community Crew meeting this week where we celebrated our second Crew Champions! We have also ensured we have continued to work hard on the academic side including looking at our Accelerated Reader data and practising our handwriting. We have also enjoyed reading for pleasure!
Y3/4 have been exploring aqueducts and Roman baths this week. Did you know that Romans went to the public baths just to catch up on all the gossip? We've had great fun writing persuasive adverts to encourage people to visit the Roman baths!	Y5/6 had a brilliant community meeting this week. It was humbling to hear the wonderful work of our children and how they had demonstrated our character traits. As a twist this week, the two crews with the highest HOWL point totals competed in a task to decide the overall winner for the week. Well done Crew Jackson for narrowly beating Crew Mumby!
Y5/6 We have come to the end of our first case study (geography) in Y5/6. To showcase all we have learnt, we completed a reflection on our learning and how this answers our guiding question. We explained what the equator and tropics are, recalled our knowledge of the physical features of South America and showcased our understanding of deforestation and the devastating impact it has on the rainforest itself and the earth as a whole. Next week we will work as scientists as we embark on case study 2: biology!
