

Expedition:

EYFS have been exploring and sharing their knowledge of Harvest. The children created anchor charts in their crews and had a fun session with Mrs Walton choosing from activities linked to Harvest and the fruit and vegetables we see in Autumn. We are very much looking forward to Pastor Kevin next week!

KS1 have had the best week as our case study about the Great Fire of London comes to an end. Mr Kershaw supported us with burning down the houses from Pudding Lane that the children made. Not only did it give us a fantastic opportunity to learn about fire safety first hand but we saw fire breaks were so important and this was a significant lesson that was learnt from 1666.

Y3/4 have been focusing on Roman soldiers this week and have looked at the positives and negatives of being a soldier. Did you know that Roman soldiers had to serve for 25 years and weren't allowed to be married? We have used our knowledge in our final touchdown to write a persuasive advert to encourage people to sign up to be a Roman soldier!

Y5/6: This week has seen children in the upper phase begin their second case study: biology. We have built our background knowledge of animal groups and used their characteristics to classify them. We wrote like scientists to explain our reasons for each classification of various rainforest animals. Next week will see us build on this knowledge to learn about plant and animal adaptation. We will study the work of Charles Darwin.

Character Growth (Crew):

EYFS Crew have thoroughly enjoyed reading week this week! We have explored Autumn poetry and talked together about kindness. Our hoWL of the week is 'I can work independently on tasks' and the children have modelled to each other what independence looks like in many words!

KS1 have had a fantastic reading week. We loved our visit to Thorne library where we explored fiction and non fiction books. The children watched a live session with an author as he read his book to them and talked about the characters. In line with reading week we have looked at poetry books and discussed why we liked some much more than others. They have also really enjoyed our PCSO visitor, where the children were encouraged to ask questions about his job and made him feel very welcome. It has been a very busy week but we have enjoyed these fantastic experiences together.

Y3/4 have had the best week celebrating reading this week! We enjoyed a trip to Thorne library, watching a hangout from the author who writes Shifty McGifty and reading stories on The Windrush Generation. We also had the pleasure of a real author and illustrator visiting us which was so much fun!

Y5/6: Another great week in crew with a focus on reading! All crews have enjoyed their visits to the library and there has been much enthusiasm to crack the code! In addition to reading week, we also began our focus on Black History Month by hearing about some inspiring and influential people of the past. We have planned in many sessions to celebrate Black History Month; it is important to learn about diversity, respect and equality.
