#### Expedition:

In key stage 1 we have been learning about Florence Nightingale and how she was such a significant person and the impact that she has had on medicine for the better. The children have been filling in their knowledge organisers and we have been reading a great book called Vlad and the Florence Nightingale Adventure.

In Year 3/4 we have finished off our learning on the Romans in Doncaster and we have worked hard on our non-chronological reports. It has been really interesting to learn about how the Romans changed Doncaster and how they used the River Don for transporting materials. We are now moving on to completing our research ready for our final product!

In Y5/6 we have reflected on our learning from our biology case study; we were able to recall key concepts in detail such as animal classification, adaptation and evolution. We presented what we found out in creative ways and assessed our learning against our expedition rubric. Next week we are looking forward to engaging in our next case study: D&T!

#### Character Growth (Crew):

We have been preparing the children in key stage 1 for anti-bullying week next week. We have watched videos and discussed how we could be a hero if we saw anyone getting bullied and the children spent time thinking about scenarios and what would be the best way to deal with them.

In crew this week, Y3/4 have thought about Remembrance Day and have enjoyed making poppies to decorate our school corridors. We have also started the preparation for our Student Led Conferences which will take place after Christmas!

Y5/6 have focused on beginning our preparations for Student Led Conferences which will take place after Christmas. We critiqued a good example before discussing positive ways to greet our visitors. Alongside this, we have focused on our character trait: respect. We discussed ways in which we should be respectful when using social media. In groups, we created anchor charts with the best tips!
