Expedition:

In EYFS the children have finished creating their beautiful work ready to showcase their outdoor display boards at our celebration of learning. The children have been using their phonics skills to write words and captions to label the characters in our story of the week' it was a dark cold night!'

Character Growth (Crew):

EYFS Crew have been exploring their HOWL of the week 'I can challenge myself' as they explore the numbers 1-5 and retell our stroy of the week. I wonder if they can recall it at home and tell you the story? We have learnt many songs and poems as we have thought carefully about kindness in anti-bullying week.

In year 1 and 2 we have been learning all about Florence Nightingale and researching facts and information so that we can create a fact file on her. We have also had family learning where parents have donated small presents for the children to wrap as a gift for children in our community. Thank you so much for the support we have had with this.

Year 1 and 2 have been discussing anti bullying week in crew sessions this week and they have been preparing for their student led conferences by completing all of their challenges in their maths books and choosing their best pieces of work.

In Year 3 and 4, we have enjoyed working towards our expedition product this week! We've been working hard on our non-chronological report writing for our Roman website which will be coming soon! We have also started our Case Study 3 (History and Geography) and are excited to learn all about the Celts who revolted against the Romans!

Y3/4 - This week our focus has been on anti-bullying and we have been making lots of noise about bullying! We have looked at ways we can be kind and the things we can do to ensure everyone feels happy and safe! We've also continued our preparation for our Student Led Conferences!

Y5/6- This week we have fully engaged in our D&T case study. We have developed our understanding of success criterias to plan our photo frames. Children needed to consider purpose and purpose whilst planning their design. Children had an opportunity to be creative with how they would decorate their frames too. Next week, we will be constructing our frames using a range of tools.

Y5/6- This week has seen us shine a spotlight on anti-bullying by getting involved in the national initiative. We have discussed our thoughts on bullying and ways we can prevent it. Specific to Y5 and Y6, we spent time on banter vs bullying and how this can be felt differently by the people involved. We talked about what is harmless and what would be harmful.
