EYFS are hooking into case study 3 this week as they begin to explore the question 'What changes do we see in Autumn?' We have been noticing, talking about and observing the changes that we see. The children will be culminating their learning in a mini product! Watch this space!	EYFS are getting smart by supporting each other in their crews this week. The children have also been thinking carefully about what it means to be a good friend and how this links to our be kind HOWLS!	
Ks1 have been preparing for their amazing Pride of Thorne Awards this week! I am so impressed with their attitudes towards their learning and the evening was a complete success. What a team you are! Well done key stage 1.	Key Stage 1 have spent a crew session this week for Non- fiction November reading non fiction books. Our favourites were ones that linked to water and recycling, as that is the theme for this year. They've learnt lots of great facts, well done guys.	
Y3/4 have enjoyed reading Captive Celt this week and writing a diary entry imagining we were the Celt who had been captured! We've also really enjoyed learning about the Celtic tribes who revolted against the Romans including the Iceni Tribe and the Catuvellauni Trip! We've written some beautiful fact files about Boudicca as part of our Expedition lessons.	Year 3/4 have looked through our books from this year to reflect on some pieces of work that we found challenging.
