

Expedition:

In Key stage 1 this week, we have been doing our reflections for our whole expedition. We have remembered lots of facts about Florence Nightingale, Martin Luther King and The great fire of London. I am so impressed with the dates that they know and the knowledge they have.

In Year 3 and 4, we celebrated the end of our expedition with our presentation of learning. We shared the website we created (with the support of our Comms team) and celebrated our learning journey that led us to that point. We have loved learning about the Romans and all of the teachers are so proud of the knowledge that has been learnt during this expedition!

In upper key stage 2, we brought a close to our expedition by hosting a successful Celebration of Learning (CoL) and sharing our product with a wider audience. The quality and craftsmanship of the work was impressive and humbling. The Y5/6 team is proud of the children's efforts during this expedition. Keep your eyes peeled around Thorne. You might see our work 'pop' up soon!

Character Growth (Crew):

In key stage 1 we have been busy completing reading and maths assessments this week and we are proud of our achievements. We also know that we still need to improve our maths arithmetic, especially multiplication and division but we all agree that we will work hard to do this.

In Year 3 and 4, we have thought about our character traits and have started to work together to create classroom resources that we can keep referring to throughout the year. We also looked at the particular character trait of 'respect' and what this might look like to respect ourselves and others.

In Y5/6 crew sessions, we have reflected on our Habits of Work and Learning (HOWLs) this term. The children critiqued their term so far. Following this, we held debrief circles focused on ways we can demonstrate positive HOWL behaviours.
