In EYFS this week the children have been creating artwork to combine together into the product that all children will receive. A bin sticker to remind us to recycle and care for our world. The children have also explored citizenship and have been learning about who our Prime Minister is and what his job is.
In expedition this week, key stage 1 have been geographers and have been creating their own maps, using some aerial photographs of Thorne. They have included landmarks, a key and road names. I think they look super and the children have tried so hard to make sure they are accurate.
