Literacy Focus

Comprehension

Nursery:

- Talk about stories they have seen and heard.
- Make up stories from the pictures.

Reception:

- Has a love of stories and listens attentively to story time.
- Enjoy talking to others about favourite stories.
- Is able to talk about the main events in the story and predict what might happen.
- Can retell a story using role play or small world resources, using some story language.

Word Reading

Nursery:

- Join in with rhymes and fill in all the missing word.
- Develop their phonological awareness, so that they are beginning to spot and suggest rhymes.

Reception:

- Can recognise all single graphemes
- Can read cvc words containing a-z, ff, ll, ss
