The children have explored how the different characters felt linking this back to kindness and showing care for one another.   | The EYFS children have been learning about their 'work hard' HOWLS this week focussing on doing their very best work! The children have been thinking about what makes them special and why they are special to their family and how each family is unique!  |  |
| In key stage 1 the children have enjoyed a visit from a castle expert who brought the activity to life. He recapped the learning that has taken place during the History case study and it was great to see the children so engaged!   | In crew this week, key stage 1 have enjoyed discussing their arithmetic scores and making pledges to improve on their own maths progress. We have enjoyed listening to LeAnn Rimes as part of our country music week too!  |  |
| In Expedition, the children in Y3/4 are bringing their first case study to a close. We have enjoyed learning about evacuations, the Blitz and rationing. Using this learning, we wrote emotive narrative pieces that will appear in our final product. We are looking forward to our next case: Art! In this case study, we will study the work of David Hockney and his use of digital art. | In Y3/4 Crews, we have continued to study British Values. We have unpicked the meaning of tolerance and how it is important to show tolerance to people with different ideas and beliefs to your own. We have also enjoyed our Friday singing sessions; we have been learning the song, 'I'm on my way' by Phil Collins which also features in the Disney film' Brother Bear'. |  |
