Expedition	Crew

EYFS have taken part in rec<mark>ycling week this week as they answer</mark> the question 'how can we care for nature?' The children enjoyed the story 'The smartest giant in town' and thought about how the giant showed kindness.

In key stage 1, we have started our new case study, which is all about materials. We have looked at the names and properties of a variety of everyday materials. Our book for the next few weeks is The three little pigs and we will be doing experiments based on the materials used to build houses in the book.

In expedition, Y3/4 have started our second case study by appreciating local artist, David Hockney. We found out about his style of work and the media he uses. We looked closely at his more recent work as he uses an iPad to create it. We are looking forward to using digital products to create art.

In Expedition this week, Year 5/6 have been busy writing their final touchdown narratives based on the story Spaceboy by David Walliams. We've also touched down in our case study 1 and consolidated our learning on the Earth, sun and moon!

In EYFS Crew sessions this week the children have enjoyed many reading activities including cosy story time, a story vote and a pyjama day with a teddy bears picnic! The Reception children have begun their rainbow challenge showing how they can work independently.

In KS1 we have celebrated the progress the children are making in big maths beat that tests each week and we have learnt about Black History month and why it is important to be celebrated. on top of all this, we have reminded ourselves about how we are safe online and what we do if we come across something we don't like on a tablet or device...stop...close...tell. What a great week year 1 and 2!

In Y3/4 crew sessions, we unpicked our most recent arithmetic assessments to identify strengths, successes and areas for development. We will use this data to work on the questions that we found tricky.

In Year 5/6 this week, Crew Ambler braved the rain to visit the Pentecostal charity shop to deliver our uniform and clothes donations. We've also thought about individual liberty as well as rocked out to our Friday song - We will rock you!
