Expedition:

Key stage 1 have been amazing this week completing their assessments. We are so proud of the progress they have made. We have also loved science week where we have taken part in numerous science experiments, where we have learnt about floating, sinking, forces, gravity and air resistance. What a fantastic week!

In Key stage 1 we have had a video call with other crews to discuss online safety. We questioned the other crews about what they would do in certain situations and it was great to hear that the children understood what to do in situations that made them feel uncomfortable online.

Y3/4: This week in our expedition, we have been developing our knowledge of light. We discovered that light travels in straight lines and used this understanding to explore how shadows are formed and change. Through practical investigations, we observed how light interacts with different objects, deepening our scientific thinking. It has been an exciting and illuminating week of learning!

Y3/4: This week in Crew, we explored the concept of Individual Liberty as part of our work on British Values. We discussed what it means to have the freedom to make choices, express our opinions, and take responsibility for our actions while respecting others. Through engaging activities and thoughtful discussions, we deepened our understanding of why individual liberty is important in our daily lives. It was a fantastic opportunity for everyone to reflect on their rights and responsibilities!

This morning we have enjoyed the opportunity to get out in the sunshine and explore the new play equipment at the park. It was very exciting to get the chance to go to the amazing new play area before it is officially opened to the public tomorrow. We also loved searching for the rocks that the year 2 children decorated and hid in the park for us to find. 

Parent Information

NHS Pharmacy First Service

Did you know that the NHS Pharmacy First Service enables children and adults to get convenient access to healthcare advice and treatment where appropriate, for seven common conditions without the potential delay of having to wait for a GP appointment?

Accessing the service may mean that can help children feel better and back to school as quickly as possible, as well as supporting parents/carers to also get better if they are unwell with one of the conditions covered under the service.

There is no need to make an appointment; parents or carers can pop into their local Boots pharmacy with their child and ask for help under the service.

Support for the following conditions can be accessed under the service, free of charge (unless NHS prescription charges apply):

Common condition	Patient eligibility
Earache	1 to 17 years
Impetigo	1 year and over
Infected insect bites and stings	1 year and over
Sore throats	5 years and over
Sinusitis	12 years and over
Uncomplicated urinary tract	Women 16 to 64 years
Shingles	18 years and over

- **Sinusitis** (adults and children aged 12 years and over)
- Sore throat adults and children aged 5 years and over)
- Earache (children and young adults aged 1 year to 17 years)
- Infected insect bite (adults and children aged 1 year and over)
- Impetigo
 - (adults and children aged 1 year and over)
- Shingles (adults aged 18 years and over)
- Urinary tract infection
