Absences If your child is absent you must contact school everyday informing the reason your child is absent. If we don't hear from you daily this could trigger a safe & well homevisit.




Punctuality - We need to improve punctuality! Please ensure you arrive at school on time!



In EYFS this week the children have been taking part in chosen activities to support their learning from the Spring Term. The children have enjoyed creating cards for Mother's Day and reading and writing sentences about Spring.

KS1 completed their expedition by welcoming family members into class to see the skills they had developed during their DT lessons. They chopped, grated, sliced and cut a variety of fruit and vegetables to share with their families.

This week, Year 3 and 4 showcased a fantastic Presentation of Learning in front of parents, demonstrating their hard work and knowledge with confidence. They embodied the character trait of courage, speaking clearly and proudly in front of a large audience. It was wonderful to see them share their learning! In addition, the children have been busy making the final touches to the well-being diary before it goes to print. They have put a lot of thought and effort into creating something meaningful, and we can't wait to see the finished product!

This week, Year 5 and 6 celebrated their expedition by sharing their learning with parents and selling our beautiful new product! We've had a really successful expedition learning about influential figures from the civil rights movement and it has really developed the children's empathy.






