Expedition:

We have had such a great week in key stage 1 learning about monarchs in our first case study. We have had research lessons on Henry VIII, Queen Victoria and Queen Elizabeth II. The children have learnt some great facts about them and have worked as teams to record them and share their new knowledge with each other.

This term, Year 3 and 4 pupils have been developing their geography skills, focusing on tectonic plates and how their movement causes earthquakes. The children have shown great curiosity and enthusiasm as they explored how the Earth's surface is made up of moving plates and what happens when they collide or slide past one another. It has been fantastic to see them making connections and asking thoughtful questions.

Year 5 have begun their first history case study linked to mining and have completed some headstock artwork using pastels to create a silhouette. The children have created timelines based on important dates that they have researched and are looking forward to delving deeper into what working conditions were like for miner children and their families. Year 6 have continued working really hard in the run up to SATs with a focus on reading, maths and SPaG. The children are showing lots of motivation and continue to show great development in their arithmetic skills! We are really proud of the efforts they are putting in.

Crew:

In crew this week in Key stage 1, we have reminded ourselves about individual liberty and have learnt about St George and how he was important because he stood up for what he believed was right.

This week in Crew sessions, Year 3 and 4 have been learning about the importance of rules and why we have laws as part of our British Values. The children explored how rules help keep our school community safe, fair and respectful, before making links to how laws work in the wider world. Through thoughtful discussions, they reflected on how rules and laws help people live and work together successfully.

In Year 5/6, we have focused on British Values including rules of law and individual liberty. We explored the difference between rules and laws and how the law applies to children. We also looked at who makes law and who is able to change the law.




