

Expedition: Crew: The EYFS children have begun exploring Case Study 1 and answering In Crew sessions this week the EYFS children have been listening to and enjoying Jazz music! The children have been exploring one of the question 'How can Cinderella and the ugly sisters be friends?' The children have been exploring and retelling the story in lots of our 9 learning aliens 'Lightbulb Leo' who helps us to use our ideas different ways! Family learning was so much fun and a huge thank in our play and pretend! you to everyone who joined us. This week in Crew sessions, Year 3 and 4 pupils have been learning Children in Year 3 and 4 continue to be fascinated by their current expedition. This week, they have been busy exploring the structure of about human rights and exploring why they are important for volcanoes, learning about key features such as the magma chamber, everyone. We have used our new knowledge to take part in vents, and crater. 


