Expedition: Crew:

The EYFS children have worked hard on their product this week. The reception children have critiqued their artwork to make it their best! The nursery children have recorded their wishes for what they would like when they are older! These will be on a QR code on their magic wand.

In Crew sessions this week the EYFS children are looking at 'Exploring Eddie' one of the learning aliens and how we can explore the world around us. The children have also been thinking about how they can keep their mind and body healthy.

In Key stage 1, we have started to learn about space and we had a fantastic research lesson about Helen Sharman. She is an astronaut from Sheffield and such an inspiration! We also loved our family learning session where parents and carers helped the children to make their own rockets! I have even been sent videos of the rockets being launched at home...amazing work!

In crew this week we are really proud of the children's academic progress, particularly in big maths, beat that tests that they do every week. We love to look at our progress improving each week and receive shout outs.

Year 3 and 4 children conducted excellent fieldwork during their visit to Magna, where they had the exciting opportunity to work alongside a geology expert. Through hands-on activities and close observation, they deepened their understanding of different types of rocks and how they are formed. The experience allowed them to explore real-world examples of sedimentary, igneous, and metamorphic rocks, helping to bring their classroom learning to life

In Y3/4 crews, we have analysed our Accelerated Reader data to reflect on our current progress and identify areas for growth. By reviewing our reading habits, quiz scores, and comprehension levels, we gained a clearer understanding of our individual strengths and where we can improve. As a result, each of us has made personal pledges to take positive steps towards becoming more confident and consistent readers in the future.

Uniform / clothes:


- Nursery children are welcome to come to school in their DISCO clothes.


