Attendance:

Absences If your child is absent you must contact school <u>everyday</u> informing the reason your child is absent. If we don't hear from you daily this could trigger a safe & well homevisit.

School drive is for parents with passes only. If you are collecting your child because they are ill you are able to use the drive otherwise you must walk into school to collect or drop your children in school. This includes any children arriving late, if this is the case you will be politely declined entry.

Late Marks - **School starts at 8.30am** and this is the time all children should arrive at their classroom doors. If your child arrives late after doors close at 8.40am they will be given a Late Mark 'L' on their attendance record.

- 5 minutes late every day = Over 3 full days of school lost a year
- 15 minutes late every day = Nearly 10 full days lost each year

Expedition:

Crew:

The EYFS children have been thinking like scientists this week as they performed experiments and thought about floating and sinking. The children experimented with different materials and recorded their predictions.

In Key stage 1 this week, we have been finishing off our Man on the moon stories, as well as starting our final case study, which is all about explorers. This week we did some research on David Attenborough and began some great art work that we can't wait to finish!

Year 3 and 4 children continue to be hooked into their latest expedition: When Nature Strikes. This week we have been busy writing 'flashback' stories linked to our topic. The children have really enjoyed their writing lessons and have used a range of features to create suspense within their work. The final stories have blown us away (no pun intended!)

This week in Year 5, we enjoyed visiting the National Mining Museum. The children took part in an underground tour of a mine and were able to experience what it was like going down a mine shaft in a cage! The children enjoyed meeting some pit ponies and took part in lots of engaging activities to continue building their knowledge of mining communities. This week in our EYFS crew sessions, the children have been reflecting on their personal pledges in preparation for their transition into Year One. They have been identifying the daily habits that help keep them healthy, such as brushing their teeth and drinking plenty of water. In addition, the children have been learning British Sign Language for key greetings, including "Good morning" and "Good afternoon." They have also been enjoying learning the signs for the song *Ain't No Mountain High Enough*.

In crew this week in Key stage 1, we have continued our learning on healthy eating and we discussed the effects that unhealthy food can have on our bodies and teeth. We have also continued our learning of BSL and practising our crew songs. We have also really enjoyed listening to David Guetta during our Welcome to the day activity!

In year 3 and 4, we have discussed ways in which we can look after our teeth to avoid tooth decay. We have also talked about how everyone is different and it is important to celebrate our differences.

Year 5/6 crew sessions have looked a little different this week as we had two different assemblies covering e-safety and knife crime. In between those, we looked at our HoWLs, practised our BSL and looked at healthy eating!


