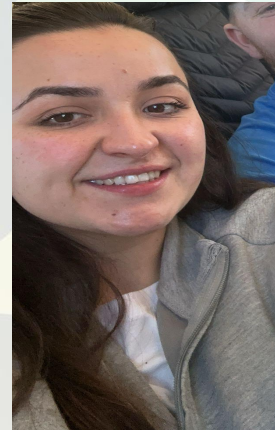


Learning Coach - Mrs Shannon Booth
