EYFS Curriculum




The Early Years Foundation Stage is the stage of education for children from birth to the end of the Reception year (when they are 5).

- Sign up to the blog on the school website for updates and information - We blog several times a week to celebrate the children's success and will include key information you will need to know (dress up days, discos, phonics sounds etc...)

How do school lunches work?

Your child may choose to have a hot school meal or bring a packed lunch. Once your child has started Nursery, they will be set up with a ParentPay account. You will be given a username and password in due course. Relish School lunches are £3.00 per meal.

You may able to apply for free school meals this if you are eligible.

Your child will eat in the hall with nursery staff and will be helped to cut and encouraged to eat a good amount safely.

Attendance & Holidays



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What happens if my child is ill or I want to take my child on holiday?

Please notify the school by calling the office if your child is unwell. If we do not hear from you, the admin team will send a follow up text to see where your child is.

If you wish to go on holiday please request a holiday form from the school office or from the nursery staff. Holidays will be authorised if your child is under the age of 5 years.

My child is not yet using the toilet confidently is this a problem?

Most children are confident toilet uses by the time they start nursery but of course some of our younger children are simply not ready. We will support children in using the toilet however they are most comfortable offering privacy and help where needed. Send your child in clothes they can manage to go to the toilet in and a few sets of spare clothes daily if they are still toilet training or if they get dirty during play



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What wrap around care is available for my child at Green Top?

Breakfast club is from 7.30am to school start time. This will be in the Nursery classroom for Early Years children. The cost is £2 per session. Children can choose from toast or cereal.

FREE after school clubs are available but fill up quickly! You can sign up for these via a google form on the school website during the first week of term.

Sunset club is from 4pm to 5.30pm, it is held in the school hall for all children and year groups and costs £5 per session. Your child will be provided with a drink and a snack.

Let's get ready!



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How can I support my child be 'Nursery ready'?

- Encourage them to wipe their own bottom
- Encourage them to pull their trousers/tights/pants up and down for the toilet
- Encourage them to put on and zip up their own coat
- Encourage your child to use a knife and fork and cut up their own food
- Encourage your child to dress and undress themselves at home
- Read a story a day together
- Sing Nursery Rhymes
- Look out for numbers 1-10 in the environment
- Hunt for 2D shapes in the environment
