# Continuing our EYFS Curriculum into reception (F2)



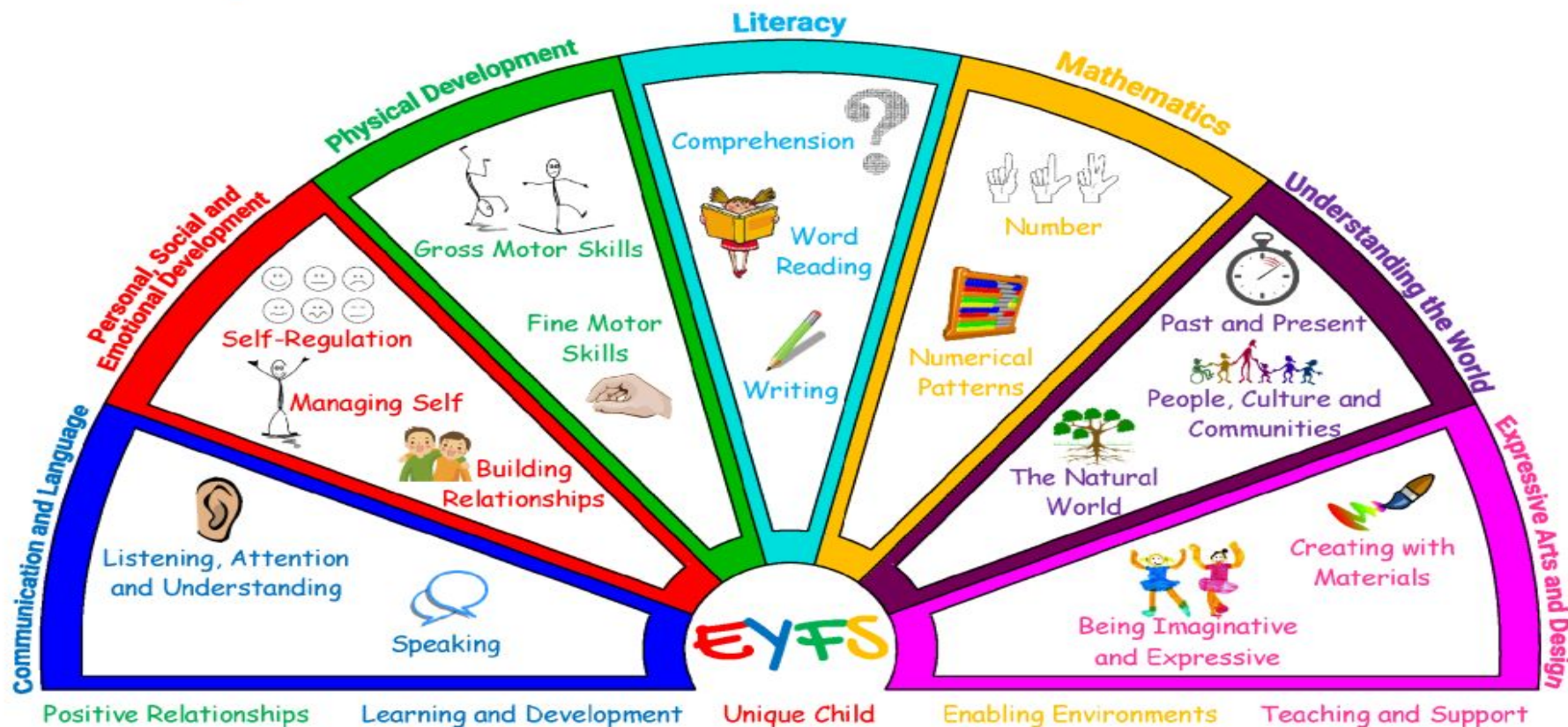
The Early Years Foundation Stage is the stage of education for children from birth to the end of the Reception year (when they are 5).

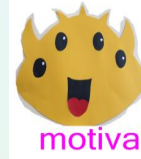

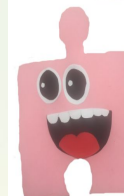

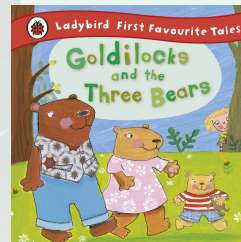

- EYFS parent voice- Google form 'all about your child'
- GreenTop school forms- google form (consents and permissions) - admission google form must be done before they start
- Class letter- teacher for next year and start date (from Tuesday 27th August 2024)
- Setting visits and sharing of information (if new to school)
- Home visit if requested

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## How do school lunches work?

Your child can choose to have a hot school meal or bring a packed lunch.

You may be able to apply for free school meals if you are eligible.

Your child will eat in the hall with reception staff and will be supported where needed.



# Attendance & Holidays



What happens if my child is ill or I want to take my child on holiday?

Please notify the school by calling the office if your child is unwell. If we do not hear from you, the admin team will send a follow up text to see where your child is or we may even do a home visit.

If you wish to go on holiday please request a holiday form from the school office. The law says that parents do **not** have the right to take their child out of school for holidays during term time following their 5th birthday and can only request leave of absence due to exceptional circumstances. If you take your child on holiday during term-time without the schools authorisation this will be recorded as unauthorised absence.







# What wrap around care is available for my child at Green Top?

Breakfast club is from 7.30am to school start time. This will be in the Nursery classroom for Early Years children. The cost is £2 per session. Children can choose from toast or cereal.

FREE after school clubs are available but fill up quickly! You can sign up for these via a google form on the school website during the first week of term.

Sunset club is from 4pm to 5.30pm, it is held in the school hall for all children and year groups and costs £5 per session. Your child will be provided with a drink and a snack.

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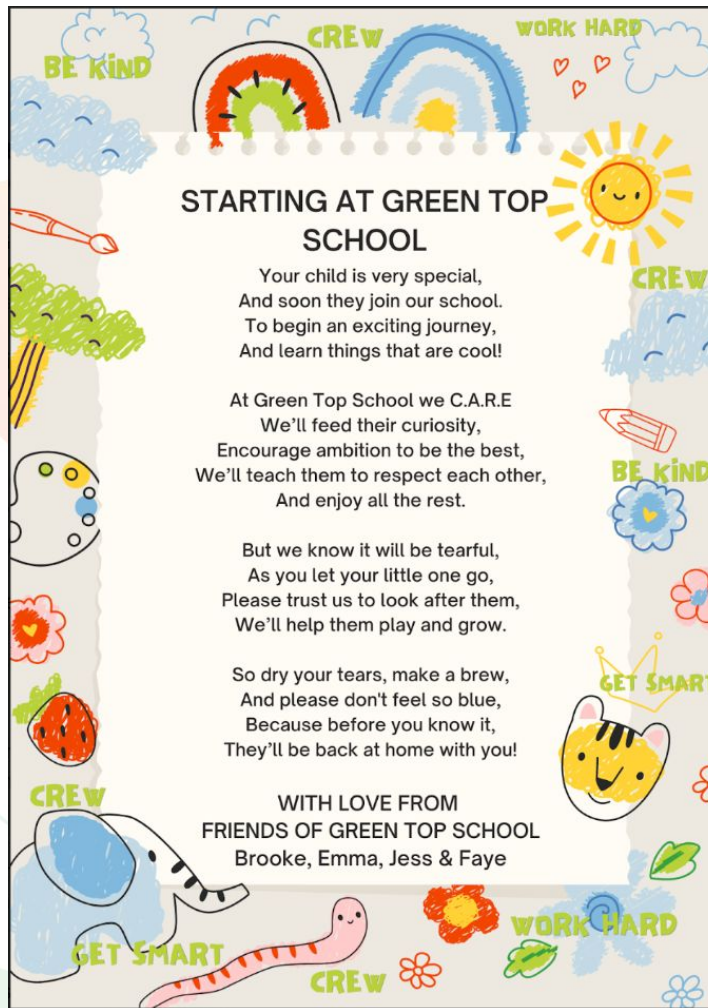
