| Absences If your child is absent you must contact school everyday informing the reason your child is absent. If we don't hear from you daily this could trigger a safe & well homevisit.  School drive is for parents with passes only. Late Marks - School starts at 8.30am and this is the time all children should arrive at their classroom doors. If your child arrives late after doors close at 8.40am they will be given a Late Mark 'L' on their attendance record.

- 5 minutes late every day = Over 3 full days of school lost a year
- 15 minutes late every day = Nearly 10 full days lost each year

If your child arrives via the school office an adult must be present as the child will need to pick their **school meal** for that day. Please note *If you are arriving late you will not be given access to use the school drive.*



### **Expedition:**

This week the EYFS children have had a fantastic presentation of learning and Cinderella's ball! We are so proud of how the learning has been shared and the products the children have made; A colouring book and magic wand!

This week, our Year 3/4 pupils have been busy preparing for their upcoming Presentation of Learning, and we're really looking forward to sharing their fantastic work with you soon. The children have shown great enthusiasm and teamwork during rehearsals, and their confidence is growing each day. In addition to this, they've tackled their assessments with impressive resilience and determination. We're incredibly proud of the effort and focus they've shown throughout the week!

In expedition this week, the Year 5 children have been geographers and have been studying maps as well as the human and physical features in our local area. Year 6 have started to present their final words and they have been beautiful reflections of their journeys at Green Top - some even resulted in a few tears!

#### Crew:

This week in Crew, our Early Years Foundation Stage children have been exploring key themes to support their personal development and wellbeing. As part of our health and self-care focus, the children have been learning to recognise common signs of illness, such as coughs, fevers, and tummy aches. These discussions have helped them begin to understand how to look after themselves and when to seek help from an adult. In connection with our ongoing work around British Values, we have focused on Individual Liberty, encouraging children to make independent choices in their learning and daily routines. This has been meaningfully linked to their learning behaviours, attitudes, and recent assessments, promoting a sense of responsibility and self-awareness. The children have responded positively, demonstrating growing confidence in both their health knowledge and decision-making skills.

This week, our Year 3/4 pupils have been learning about the risks associated with smoking and the harmful effects it can have on the body. The children showed great maturity in their discussions, which led to some thought-provoking conversations. We also explored how modern alternatives, such as vapes, are now recognised as potential health risks too. It was fantastic to see the children so engaged, asking insightful questions and developing their understanding of how to make informed, healthy choices.

This week in crew, Year 5/6 have been enjoying Glastonbury festival music as our welcome to the day! We were gobsmacked at how many people were in the crowds! We've also looked at our recent piece of writing and critiqued it to see what we need to do to improve next time. For our British Values crew we focused on individual liberty looking at careers and the freedom to make choices.


