Attendance:

Absences If your child is absent you must contact school <u>everyday</u> informing the reason your child is absent. If we don't hear from you daily this could result in a safe & well homevisit.

School drive is for parents with passes only. If you are collecting your child because they are ill you are able to use the drive otherwise you must walk into school to collect or drop your children in school. This includes any children arriving late, if this is the case you will be politely declined entry.

Late Marks - School starts at 8.30am and this is the time all children should arrive at their classroom doors. If your child arrives late after doors close at 8.40am they will be given a Late Mark 'L' on their attendance record.

Remember you can access dates on the parent calendar:









- 5 minutes late every day = Over 3 full days of school lost a year
- 15 minutes late every day = Nearly 10 full days lost each year

Arriving late to school - dinner choice - If your child arrives late via the school office an adult must be present as the child will need to pick their school meal for that day. Please note there won't be a photo choice, it will be from the paper menus - we would like to make you aware that sometimes the paper menus do change so if your child has chosen from the paper menu they are not always guaranteed their choice. If you arrive after 9:30am, your child won't have an option for their lunch, they will be given either wrap or pasta depending on the choice for that day. Please note If you are arriving late you will not be given access to use the school drive.

We are here to help - If you're struggling with morning routines or getting to school on time, please speak to us. We want to support you in making every day count for your child.




