

## Review of Year 7 Catch-Up Premium Spending

2015 - 2016

## Allocation = £12,500

Action 1	support year 7 students who did not achieve the expected standard in reading or maths at the end of Key Stage 2.  In 2015 -2016, the expected standard was a Level 4 in reading and maths.  Appropriate Curriculum  An additional Skills Based Curriculum (SBC) Group was set up in Year 7. This group was taught SBC for 12 out of 50 periods per fortnight.  Appropriate teaching groups/sets  Quality First Teaching.  A primary trained teacher and the SENDCO deliver the Skills Based Curriculum to this particular group with an emphasis on integrating literacy and numeracy skills into the lessons.  The primary trained teacher taught Mathematics to one set of students.  Effective use of student data to inform planning to meet individual learning needs.  'Challenge for All' was the pedagogical and C.P.D. focus for 2015/16	Cost Staffing £12,500
