

Rednock STEM Ambassador Programme 2019-2020

If you study Science, have a passion for it, and want to gain a qualification that will set you apart from the crowd on your CV and in UCAS applications; then becoming a STEM ambassador is a fantastic opportunity for you. During the programme you will develop a range of management and communication skills and it is also great fun.

In order to meet the criteria for the certificate you would need to show evidence of a minimum of 5 outreach STEM events (examples of where you have delivered STEM events to the wider community) over the course of the year. You would be expected to initially assist me in the delivery of workshops at other schools or external agencies and latterly you will then lead on these yourselves. There is also scope to gain training in mentoring within the science department and to shadow the lab technicians so that you can gain a practical working knowledge of how scientific experiments are prepared.

If you are interested in this brilliant and unique opportunity that can only be had at two schools nationally then I need you to complete the attached form on the reverse of this letter explaining why you would like to be involved in promoting STEM subjects within our partner schools and why you think you would make a good STEM Ambassador. The submission date and time for the applications is 12pm Friday 19th July and all need to be handed in directly to Mr Mabbott or Dr Craig, a scanned copy emailed to Mr Mabbott's address or a hard copy placed in Mr Mabbott's pigeon hole.

Successful applicants will be notified in September term 1 of the 2019-2020 academic year.
