Dear Parent / Carer

As we approach the final stage of Year 11 and 13, I am writing to inform you of the arrangements for Terms 5 and 6 and update you on the celebration events.

### **Reports for Year 11 and Year 13**

The final Year 11 and Year 13 report will be sent home during the last week of this Term (week beginning 24th May). This report will consist of a written Tutor report only. This is due to the changes in the way qualifications are being awarded in Summer 2021 using Teacher Assessed Grades. Schools are not allowed to share details of the grades submitted to the exam boards until the designated results day:

- **A-Level and AS-Level Results:** **Tuesday 10th August**
- **GCSE Results:** **Thursday 12th August**

### **TERM 5**

Students in Year 11 and 13 will continue with their studies up until the completion of their final assessments. Students will continue to attend all lessons in Term 5 where the focus of the lesson may include opportunities to:

- Study missed units of work that were not covered due to missed teaching time
- Conduct some enrichment activities linked to the subject area
- Revise for outstanding assessments

### **Celebration Days**

The Year 13 celebration day will be on **Thursday 27th May** and will mark the end of the students' time at Rednock School. The Sixth Form team will be confirming the details of this event in a separate letter to the parents of Year 13 students.

The Year 11 celebration day will be on **Friday 28th May** and will officially mark the end of students' time in Key Stage 4.

### **Term 6**

In Term 6, there will be a variety of activities to support students with their post-16 progression routes. This will include:

- Rednock Sixth Form transition days and A-level taster sessions: students who are returning to Rednock in September are expected to attend these sessions.
- A selection of online activities to support and develop students' study skills. This will be particularly useful for students who are moving onto college to study specialist courses.

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- 1:1 support for students who have not secured an appropriate placement for September. Designated staff will offer advice and guidance and help students with applications.

### Celebration Events Updates

#### Class of 2021 Yearbook

Please be aware that to be part of the Yearbook students need to sign up using an online system. The instructions on how to do this have been sent to your child via their Rednock School email address. If your child does not sign up and complete a profile page they risk not being part of the Yearbook or having a featured profile. Students have been asked to complete their profile page by **Friday 7th May 2021**.

The cost of the Yearbook will be £17.76. If your child would like a Yearbook, please go to <https://allyearbooks.co.uk/buy/15190> where you can order and pay online. Yearbooks need to be ordered by **Friday 28th May 2021**.

Yearbooks will be available for collection on the GCSE Results Day in August, Thursday 12th August 2021.

#### Sign Off

On the last day of school Year 11 students are asked to complete a Clearance Form to ensure the correct items are returned to Rednock School prior to the summer holidays. In order for your child to be eligible to attend the end of year celebration they will be asked to return the following items:

- Subject Textbooks;
- Outstanding Library Books;
- Locker Key (please be aware that if your child has lost their locker key they will be required to pay a fee of £5).


