### **Preparing for Exams**

The Easter holidays are hugely important for Year 11 students; they must rest and recharge ready for the challenges of Terms 5 and 6, but they must also revise and prepare. Do work with your child to prepare a [revision timetable](#) to make sure that sufficient time is set aside over the 2 weeks to revise. All students have been issued with a paper copy of a blank timetable that they can use for this purpose.

### **Year 11 Awards Evening - Thursday 12<sup>th</sup> May 2022**

The Year 11 Awards Evening is taking place on Thursday 12<sup>th</sup> May at 5.30pm. If you wish to attend with your child please complete this [form](#) by Thursday 14<sup>th</sup> April 2022. Tickets for the evening will be sent home at the beginning of Term 5 to those of you who have completed the form. The Year 11 Awards Evening is a celebration of the successes which have been achieved over the time your child has attended Rednock School. During this important evening, students will receive their Achievement Folders containing their most recent report, attendance certificate, as well as certificates for a range of other achievements and responsibilities from their time with us so far. There will be awards for outstanding effort across all subjects and the presentation of two special celebratory awards. There will also be musical performances by students from the year group and a number of speeches commemorating their time. We look forward to seeing you on Thursday 12<sup>th</sup> May.

### **Celebration Day - Friday 13<sup>th</sup> May 2022**

The Year 11 Celebration Day will take place on Friday 13<sup>th</sup> May. Students will have the opportunity to sign shirts in the Main Hall in the morning, and 'breakfast' will be provided. Students will attend lessons across the course of the Celebration Day. Period 5 will be a celebration 'assembly' that will include entertainment and funny awards. We do ask that all Year 11 students enter the building using the Dining Hall entrance.

### **Clearance Process - Thursday 23<sup>rd</sup> June 2022**

Before Year 11 students leave us, they are asked to complete a Clearance Certificate to ensure the correct items are returned. Students are asked to return subject textbooks, outstanding library books and their locker key. The deadline for completion of the Clearance Form is Thursday 23<sup>rd</sup> June 2022, after the last full cohort exam (Physics).

After the Physics exam on Thursday 23<sup>rd</sup> June, four tables will be set up outside of the main reception foyer. One staff member will be present at each table. These tables will be organised into communities and students will be asked to hand in their locker key and return their signed Clearance Certificate in exchange for their prom ticket on this date.

## **Examinations**

If they wish to remain on site before or after exams to revise, they are welcome to use the Dining Hall, outside spaces or the LRC if available for quiet revision and preparation.

All students who have applied to Rednock 6th Form have been invited and detailed arrangements for the day will be sent out at the start of Term 6.
