Rednock School Uniform

We are writing to update you regarding the supply of Rednock School uniform.

We regret to inform you that we have recently been notified that Monkhouse, who we had been working closely with to become our second uniform supplier, will no longer be stocking our school uniform as previously planned. This decision was unexpected and has come as a disappointment to the school.

We are currently in discussions with Monkhouse to explore whether a resolution can be reached. In the meantime, we understand that this news may be particularly inconvenient for families living on the Gloucester side of our catchment area, and we sincerely apologise for any disruption this may cause.

In the meantime, we would like to reassure you that **Bateman's of Stroud** will continue to be the main supplier of our school uniform, as they have been for many years. Bateman's have consistently provided a reliable and high-quality service, and we are pleased to confirm their continued partnership with the school. Bateman's will also be present at our **Year 7 Introduction Evening on Wednesday 9th July from 3:30pm**, where they will showcase uniform items and have stock available for purchase. Additionally, Bateman's will continue to sell uniform from their Stroud store, as well as via their online shop, offering convenient delivery direct to the school for your collection.

We would also like to take this opportunity to remind you that, over the past two years, we have made a number of changes to our [Uniform Policy](#). These changes allow parents greater flexibility to purchase many non-branded uniform items from the supplier of your choice, provided they meet the school's uniform criteria. We are also incredibly proud of our partnership with the [Rednock pre loved uniform](#) team which is run by a group of fantastic parent volunteers. This team will be present at the evening on 9th July, found in the DT atrium, and would be happy to help you with any uniform enquiries. Please also chat to them if you would like to get involved.
