Re: Remote Learning Arrangements for Wednesday 24th and Thursday 25th June

Following Mr Stratford's previous communication confirming the full school closure on Wednesday 24th June and Thursday 25th June (see [here](#)), I am writing to outline how learning will be delivered. Over these two days, students are encouraged to work from home and keep on top of their studies. Here is a summary of how remote learning will operate:

Timetable: Students must follow their normal school timetable for both days.

Accessing Work: Teachers will set subject-specific, appropriate work on ClassCharts. This can be found under the Homework section of their classes.

Teacher Support: Teaching staff will be available via email during lessons to provide support, answer questions, and assist any students who need help with their tasks.

Please ensure your child logs into ClassCharts to access the tasks set by their teacher. While they are expected to complete the work to the best of their ability, they may access it at any point during the day to fit your home circumstances. However, please keep in mind that if they need any support, their subject teacher will only be available to help via email during the timetabled lesson period.

Thank you for your continued support and we look forward to welcoming the students back to school on Friday.
