- There will be an extended break from 11.05am during which students can purchase food and collect lunches.
- Please remind your child to clear their lockers before the end of the week.

Across the Summer:

While staff will be on-site throughout the summer to run reception and coordinate various site improvements, teaching staff will not be routinely available.

Key Dates:

- **Thursday, 13th August - [A Level Results Day](#):** Staff will be present to support students receiving their results.
- **Thursday, 20th August - [GCSE Results Day](#):** Staff will be in school, available to support students receiving their results and assist with Sixth Form enrolment.
- **Tuesday 1st & Wednesday 2nd September - Inset Days:** The school reopens for **staff only**.
- **Thursday 3rd September - Year 7 & 12's Return:** School reopens for **Year 7 & 12 students only**.
- **Friday 4th September - School year commences:** The school reopens for all remaining students. Normal school timings apply. Students will receive their timetable, school planner and 'Phone Pouch' as part of an extended tutor time.

When September arrives, please ensure your child returns to school in full uniform, equipped with the necessary materials to learn effectively. They should pack for Week A on their timetable. See [here](#) for guidance if needed.
