| Topics in Year 7 | During KS3 lessons, students will cover topics from all strands of Mathematics, and will follow the order set out in the MyMaths for KS3 textbooks. These are available for students to use on the Kerboodle website. After every five chapters, students will sit a unit assessment designed to assess their knowledge of these new concepts, as well as testing their retention skills through the multiple choice section. These questions cover a variety of skills that they will have learnt previously. At the end of the year, all students will sit a terminal examination, again provided by AQA, offering questions that will prepare them for the GCSE they will sit at the end of Year 11. |
