GCSE English Literature – purchase of set text

Year 10 students will shortly begin working on their second GCSE English Literature text; Shakespeare's '**Romeo and Juliet**'.

It is important that your child has their own copy of the set text, so they can annotate and highlight it in lessons. You may already own a copy of the play, but it is easier for students if we are all working from the same edition. Please could you arrange to purchase the text before **Friday 26th March**. If you have already purchased this edition of the text for an older sibling, these can be reused.

In addition, parents often ask about purchasing study guides. These can be a useful supplement to the work and notes completed by students in class, and are beneficial as they begin to revise and prepare for their exams. We would recommend that you also buy the Snap Revision Guide for 'Romeo and Juliet'; an excellent resource specifically tailored for the AQA English Literature paper.

If your child is entitled to the Pupil Premium Grant their book, and revision guide, will be paid for by school.
