Dear Parents, Carers and Year 11 Students,

As promised before Easter, we are now in a position to confirm the practical arrangements for Year 11s last two terms at Langtree School.

I would like to start by saying how brilliant the students have been throughout the year, and particularly over the last few months, in dealing with the disruption, changes and stress of recent circumstances. We are aware of how difficult the whole situation has been and have tried to do everything possible to manage this with them. However, they have been absolutely amazing throughout. The programme for the last two terms at Langtree is as follows;

- 4th - 14th May Year 11 Assessments
- Thursday 27th May Leavers day - students invited into school (in fancy dress if they wish) to return resources, see their friends, sign shirts.
- Friday 28th May Inset Day
- 31st May - 4th June Half Term
- Mon 7th - Friday 18th June Students must be available to attend school if **the school or a specific department** requires them to complete further work or assessments.
- 21st June - 9th July Programme of optional activities to help students prepare for post 16 life. This will include a series of academic, PSHE, careers and enrichment lessons, activities and workshops that the students can sign up for in order that they are prepared for life after Langtree. We are liaising with all local post 16 providers in order to produce a coordinated plan of events which we will publish in due course.
