We are delighted to have secured tickets to see 'Romeo and Juliet' at The Globe Theatre in London on **Friday 8th October**. The performance is due to start at 7.00pm and the running time is approximately 1 hour and 50 minutes with <u>no interval</u>. As you know, Year 11 students have studied the play for their English Literature course, so it's a lovely opportunity to see the play performed live; it will be a double treat to see it at The Globe. However, we only have 26 student tickets available, and these will be allocated on a first come first served basis.

In order for this trip to take place, we are requesting a voluntary contribution of £33.70. As per our Charging and Remissions Policy, this trip will only be able to go ahead if we are able to cover the costs of this trip through voluntary contributions.
