

In School
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Students are encouraged to regularly wash their hands - external hand washing stations available • Hand sanitizer is available around school and in classrooms • One way system around the school to reduce congestion • Sanitizing wipes in classrooms to clean desks • Doors and windows kept open for ventilation • Students are asked to maintain personal space and to avoid direct contact with others • Masks can be worn if wanted • ALL students should have a mask with them at all times in school, there may be times when staff and students need to wear a mask. • Masks are recommended on school and public transport
Testing
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Students and staff are asked to carry out 2 lateral flow tests per week <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◦ If the result is positive the individual should isolate and get a PCR test ◦ If the result is void another LF test should be carried out • Test results should be reported: https://www.gov.uk/report-covid19-result • Please inform the school immediately should your child have a positive result.
Covid Symptoms in School
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • If a staff member displays symptoms, they will be sent home immediately. • If a student starts to exhibit symptoms of Covid at school they will be placed in isolation until they can be collected from school. The student will be asked to wear a mask during this time. Students cannot travel on school or public transport if they are symptomatic. • A PCR test should be arranged and the symptomatic individual should self isolate until the result is received. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◦ If the result is negative - return to school ◦ If the result is void / cannot be read - a repeat PCR test should be carried out and the individual should remain in isolation ◦ If the result is positive, remain in isolation for the required period. Other members of the household should isolate if required: https://www.nhs.uk/conditions/coronavirus-covid-19/self-isolation-and-treatment/when-to-self-isolate-and-what-to-do/ • When required to do so by Public Health England school will make contact with individuals who have been in close proximity to a confirmed case of Covid 19
At Home
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • We ask that all students carry out 2 LF tests per per week <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◦ If the result is positive the individual should isolate and get a PCR test ◦ If the result is void another LF test should be carried out • Test results should be reported: https://www.gov.uk/report-covid19-result • If a student is exhibiting symptoms of Covid 19 they should be kept at home in isolation. A PCR test should be arranged. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◦ If the result is negative - return to school ◦ If the result is void / cannot be read - a repeat PCR test should be carried out and the individual should remain in isolation ◦ If the result is positive, remain in isolation for the required period.
