Snowboarders: PLEASE WEAR YOUR WRIST PROTECTORS.

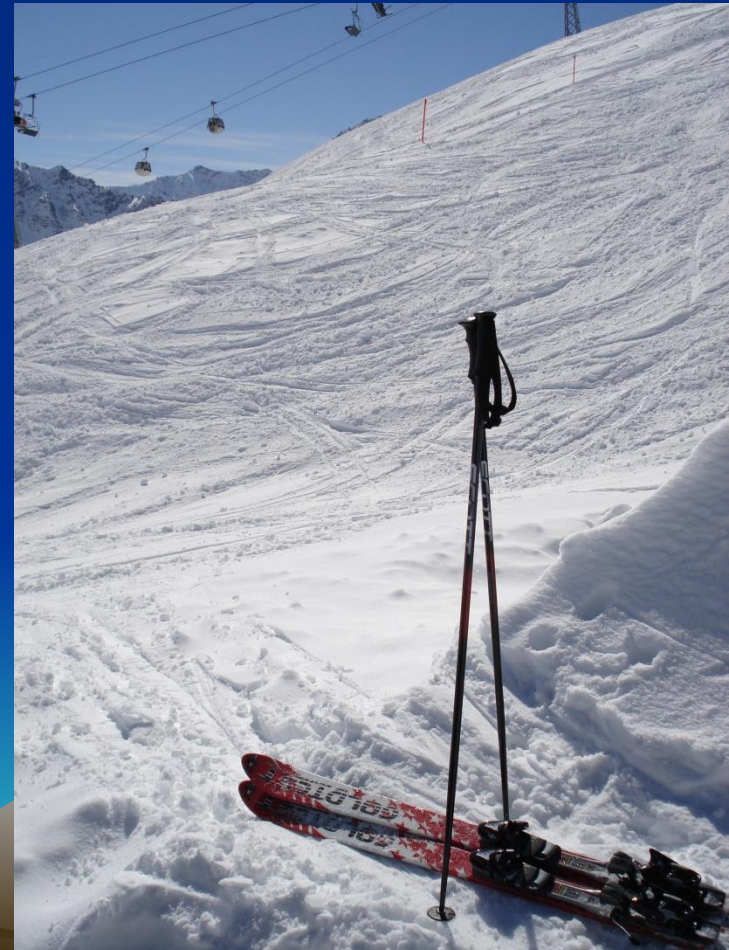


In The Unlikely Event Of An Accident

What to do next
