

Dear Parent/Guardian 3rd February 2022

I would like to offer your son/daughter the opportunity to experience the action packed Year 7 camping trip to Youlbury Scout Activity Centre. The trip will include a wealth of exciting activities, which will develop students' self-esteem, social skills and ability to work in a team. The students will be camping under canvas in the extensive and secure grounds of the Youlbury Centre. All activities are run by either a qualified member of our staff or the Youlbury Centre instructors. Please see overleaf for a list of possible activities.

Students will be travelling by coach from Langtree on **Monday 11th July at approximately 10:30am** and arriving back at school on **Friday 15<sup>th</sup> July at approximately 12:30pm**. A more exact time of departure and arrival will be provided closer to the time. The cost of the trip is **£274.00**. This will include travel, 5 nights full board tented accommodation, insurance and all day instructed activities. I am getting this letter out as early as possible in order to give you time to plan finances.

In order for students to make new friends and become closer as a year group we have always tried to encourage all students in the year to be involved in this event, which has always been a Year 7 tradition at Langtree. However, I do reserve the right to withdraw any pupil after deposits have been cashed if behaviour is deemed unacceptable or a possible danger to themselves or others.

If you would like your son/daughter to be considered for a place on this invaluable visit, please pay a non-refundable deposit of £54.00 by **Monday 14<sup>th</sup> February 2022**, and complete the consent form via SCOPAY as detailed below.

The subsequent payments of £55.00 would be due by the following dates: 23<sup>rd</sup> March, 26<sup>th</sup> April, 26<sup>th</sup> May and 16<sup>th</sup> June 2022.

Methods of payment and consent are as follows:

- Please pay by credit or debit card via the school website or the SCOPAY app. You will also give consent for the trip here
- To do this you should go to <a href="http://langtreeschool.com">http://langtreeschool.com</a> and click on the SCOPAY icon on the front page. If you don't have your pupil link code contact finance who can give you the code. Alternatively, you can download the app from your app store once you have an account set up
- You will be asked to give consent for your child to attend the trip on SCOPAY before you make the payment.

If at this stage you need more time to assess the cost of the trip but would still like your child to be considered for a place, or if your child is eligible for Pupil Premium, then please contact the finance team by phoning the school or email <a href="mailto:finance@langtreeschool.com">finance@langtreeschool.com</a>.

Registering your child on this trip represents a commitment that they will take part in this trip. Trips require extensive planning, organisation and careful costing based on the number of students participating. It is not therefore possible for students to withdraw from a trip having previously made a commitment to take part. All monies paid are on a non-refundable basis as long as the trip goes ahead. The full balance of the trip must be paid prior to the trip taking place.

The school reserves the right to withdraw students from a trip when there are concerns about behaviour, attendance or attitude. The full balance of the trip must be paid prior to the trip taking place. If booking a place on this trip please take a moment with your child to go to our website and look at our <u>Code of Conduct</u> for trips and visits. Booking a place on this trip implies agreement with this document.

All trips and visits involving students from Langtree School are always planned and risk assessed extremely carefully, in order to ensure the highest level of safety for our students as we possibly can.

**Covid safety:** If attending this trip, we advise that one of your child's twice weekly Lateral Flow tests is taken on the day of the trip. In addition, in line with the venue's guidelines, students are strongly recommended <to wear masks when inside the theatre building and during the performance>

While we will continue to offer learning in 'the outdoor classroom' as we always have done so at Langtree, I would want to assure parents that we have reviewed all of our arrangements accordingly and that we will do everything in our control to ensure that all students participating on a trip can do so with a sense of safety, confidence and enjoyment.
