Dear Parent / Carer of a year 10 student,

I am pleased to be able to offer your son/daughter the opportunity to attend a performance of 'A Christmas Carol' on Tuesday 13th December 2021 at the Reading Rep Theatre.

As part of your child's GCSE in English Literature we are studying Charles Dickens' 'A Christmas Carol' and this is a fantastic opportunity to see the story brought to life on stage.

There are **60** places available - the trip will be on SCOPAY from 1.30pm on Thursday the 15th of September until Monday the 7th of November. In the event that the trip is over subscribed, a ballot will be drawn with preference being given to students who missed out on a place on a previous theatre trip.

The cost for this trip will be **£10.50**. This includes entry to the show but parents and carers will be required to provide transport to and from the theatre. Students won't be expected to come in school uniform but will be expected to uphold the expectations of the school. As per our Charging and Remissions Policy, this trip will only be able to go ahead if we are able to cover the costs of this trip through voluntary contributions. If your child is entitled to the Pupil Premium Grant their contribution can be covered.

Along with payment, please complete the consent form, including entering contact details and any allergy/medical needs, via SCOPAY as detailed below.
