Dear Parent/ Carer

I am pleased to be able to offer your son/daughter the opportunity to visit the Oxford Playhouse Theatre on Tuesday 8th November 2022 to see Frantic Assembly's production of 'Othello'. This trip is open to Year 10 Drama GCSE students. This trip's value is two-fold, as it supports our exploration of the theatre company Frantic Assembly and we will also be reviewing it as part of our preparation for the Component 3 written examination in Year 11. Attendance is highly advised.

In order for this trip to take place, we are requesting a voluntary contribution of £37.99. As per our Charging and Remissions Policy, this trip will only be able to go ahead if we are able to cover the costs of this trip through voluntary contributions.

If your child is entitled to the Pupil Premium Grant (PPG) their contribution can be covered. You do not need to inform the school if you would like the PPG to be applied but please log in to SCOPAY to provide consent for the trip, including entering contact details and any allergy/medical needs.

There are places available for all Year 10 students on the GCSE Drama course - SCOPAY will be open online from 13.30 on the 13th September. Payment and permission must be received at the latest by 10th October.

Along with payment, please complete the consent form, including entering contact details and any allergy/medical needs, via SCOPAY as detailed below.

Methods of payment and consent are as follows:

- Please pay by credit or debit card via the school website or the SCOPAY app. You will also give consent for the trip here
- To do this you should go to http://langtreeschool.com and click on the SCOPAY icon on the front page. If you don't have your pupil link code contact finance who can give you the code. Alternatively you can download the app from your app store once you have an account set up
- You will be asked to give consent for your child to attend the trip on SCOPAY before you make the payment. Please add in your emergency contact details for the day of the trip and any allergies/medical needs, in the comments / optional note text box

The full balance of the trip must be paid prior to the trip taking place. If booking a place on this trip please take a moment with your child to go to our website and look at our <u>Code of Conduct</u> for trips and visits. Booking a place on this trip implies agreement with this document.

All trips and visits involving students from Langtree School are always planned and risk assessed extremely carefully, in order to ensure the highest level of safety for our students as we possibly can.
