## **Educational Trips and Visits**

It is a fundamental belief at Langtree that learning takes place just as much outside the classroom as within, and students have the opportunity to participate in a wide range of residential visits and day trips during their five years in the school. Residential visits include Youlbury camp for Year 7, the Year 8 French visit, a History trip to Auschwitz in Poland (every other year) and a ski trip in Year 10.

Various visits, such as theatre trips, are organised regularly by staff. These vary from year to year. At Langtree, we believe that such activities provide students with the valuable opportunities to not only learn, but develop friendships, self-esteem, leadership skills and broaden their horizons away from the school environment in the 'outdoor' classroom.
