GCSE English Literature - purchase of set text.

Year 10 students will begin working on their next set text, **Romeo and Juliet**, after February half term.

It is important that your child has their own copy of the set text so they can annotate and highlight it in lessons. You may already own a copy of the book, but it is easier for students if we are all working from the same edition. In addition, parents often ask about purchasing study guides. These can be a useful supplement to the work and notes completed by students in class and are beneficial as they begin to revise and prepare for their exams. The Collins Snap Revision Guide for 'Romeo and Juliet' is an excellent resource specifically tailored for the AQA English Literature paper. 'Romeo and Juliet Answers' is also a useful revision guide with lots of essay models and explanations of how each answer meets the assessment objectives. You can purchase this from Scholastic:
