<p><b>Changed your mind?</b></p>	<p>Email <a href="mailto:withdrawconsentSAIS@oxfordhealth.nhs.uk">withdrawconsentSAIS@oxfordhealth.nhs.uk</a> at least 1 day before the vaccination is due <b>plus</b> send in a letter to school for the urgent attention of the Immunisation team before the vaccination session. Be sure to include your child's name, Date of Birth and school in both communications.</p>
	<p>If you need an interpreter, please contact us by email and please tell us:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Your name</li> <li>• Your language spoken.</li> <li>• Your telephone number.</li> <li>• When the best time is to call you.</li> </ul>
	<p>Unsure if your child has already had these vaccinations? These vaccines are usually given from school Year 9 in the UK. If you think your child may have already received them as travel vaccines or after an injury, please check your vaccine records/ask your GP surgery <b>before</b> submitting your form.</p>
	<p>If your child missed both school sessions or does not attend school you can arrange a community clinic appointment via our website. <a href="https://oxfordhealth.nhs.uk/imms/parents/">https://oxfordhealth.nhs.uk/imms/parents/</a></p> <p>Please email us if you need any assistance.</p>
<p><b>Older children and consent.</b></p>	<p>Some young people in secondary school, who understand fully what is involved in a proposed procedure, such as vaccination, can legally provide their own consent (usually Year 9 and above)</p>
<p><b>Are your Children other vaccines up to date?</b></p>	<p>Check to ensure your child has received all the vaccinations they are eligible for including two doses of Measles Mumps Rubella vaccine (MMR). These are usually given before primary school age.
