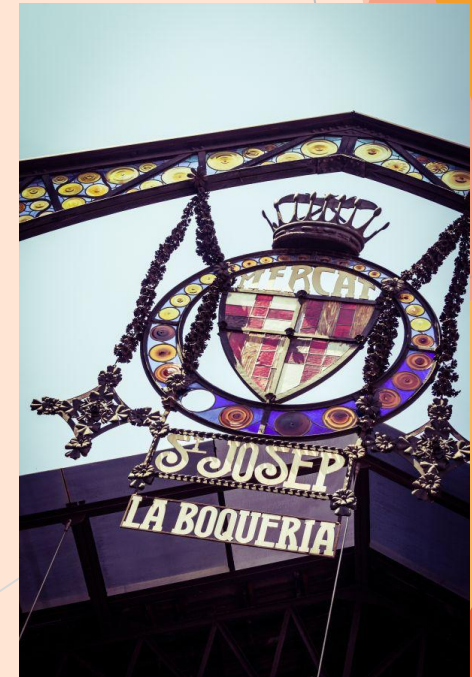

## **Cabin Bags**

Everyone can bring one small cabin bag per person on board. (Rucksack style)

# LIQUIDS ALLOWANCE on CABIN BAG

You may only carry small amounts of liquids, gels, creams and pastes. These must be in containers of 100ml or less and should be placed into one, 1 litre transparent re-sealable bag (maximum size: 20cm x 20cm) which will be screened separately at security. You must make sure that all of the above items follow our guidelines in the section for 'guidance for specific items' below.

**Please** put your toiletries, aftershaves, perfumes and cosmetics in **1 plastic bag**

# Mobile phone policy in Barcelona

# What to bring

- 1. Passport** : to be handed in to MAIN OFFICE AS SOON AS POSSIBLE
- 2. Suitable clothing** Please light but appropriate
- 3. Spending money** Everything is included so little amount for some extra
- 4. Universal adapter** Don't be left powerless and make sure the appropriate adapter for your country of destination and all required power leads are packed.
- 5. Toiletries** Toothbrush, toothpaste, soap/shower gel, sunscreen (50+) are a must as well as any medication. Wet wipes and a mini first aid kit with plasters and antiseptic wipes could be useful. Please do not forget mosquito repellent and after bites.
- 6. Towels** Bring one towel for the swimming activities and a rash vests.
- 7. Snacks** It could be a long journey and food can be pricey from petrol stations or airports. Encourage the use of environmentally friendly reusable water bottles - Must be emptied before security.
- 8. Entertainment** Something to pass the travel time such as a book, playing cards or travel games.

# First Aid

- ▶ Medical form - to complete
- ▶ All medicines to be given in a clear bag with instructions and handed to the trip leader Mrs Tontini or Mrs Allen before day of departure. Please check they are in date and clearly labelled include prescriptions please.

# Passports

# EHIC

- ▶ No copy needed. Just bring the original.
- ▶ Check in date as this will be required in an emergency.
- ▶ Will be taken in with passports.



# Safety

- ▶ Barcelona has a reputation for some crime, particularly around the tourist hotspots.
- ▶ Think carefully about how you will carry important documents and money.
- ▶ Passports will be looked after by staff and given out only at the airport and returned before arrival back at Langtree.
