Dear Parent/Carer,

We are pleased to be able to offer your child a visit to the **Netherlands and Belgium** as part of Activities Week 2027. The visit is for Year 9 students and will take place from Monday 12th July to Friday 16th July 2027.

We will be using Absolute Travel & Tours as our visit provider and we have provisional bookings at the Meininger City West Hotel Amsterdam for three nights and a fourth night at the Hi Flanders Hostel Europa Brugge.

The final details of the itinerary are yet to be fully confirmed, however we have planned to include the following activities/visits:

- Body Worlds Museum - Amsterdam
- Anne Frank House visit and workshop - Amsterdam
- Van Gogh and Rembrandt Immersive Experience - Amsterdam
- A'dam Tower Lookout and swing - Amsterdam
- Canal Boat cruise with Pizza - Amsterdam
- Duinrell Theme Park and Tiki waterslide park - Wassenaar
- Amsterdam Pancake Boat - Pannenkoekenboot - Amsterdam
- Feyenoord Stadium (guided tour) - Rotterdam
- Rotterdam Zoo
- Overnight stay and visit to Brugge with a traditional Belgian meal.
- Choco Story Museum and exploring Brugge.

While we are still finalising some details for the visit we estimate the price at £864.00 per student. We will confirm the exact price and payment amounts in October. In order to secure your child's place on the trip an initial deposit of £108.00 is required by Wednesday 9th September 2026, to ensure the travel company can complete the deposits for all provisional bookings made for this visit.

If the visit is oversubscribed students will be selected at random and a waiting list will be created. Deposits will be returned for students who are on the waiting list.

If at this stage you need more time to assess the cost of the trip but would still like your child to be considered for a place, or if your child is eligible for pupil premium, then please email finance@langtreeschool.com or phone the school and ask to speak to the finance team.

Method of payment is as follows:

- Please pay by credit or debit card via the school website
- To do this you should go to the payments page on the school website <https://langtreeschool.com/payments/> and click on the SCOPAY icon. If you don't have your pupil link code, contact finance who can give you the code.

Please be aware that when travelling your child will require a passport:

- issued less than 10 years before the date you enter the country (check the 'date of issue')
- valid for at least 3 months after the day you plan to leave (check the 'date of expiry')

Your child will also need to have his / her EHIC / GHIC card - the card is FREE. Please visit [this website](#) for more information on how to obtain a GHIC card.

Booking a place on this trip implies agreement with this document.
