English	<p>Reading – lots of bedtime stories with discussion.</p> <p>Read Write Inc phonics on you tube. Set 3 sounds – 10.30am and 1.30pm You could make your own flash cards and practise these each day. How quickly can you say all of the sounds?</p> <p>Talk for writing ‘Sidney the spider.’ Activities can be completed over the next two weeks.</p>

This could be done using a variety of containers. Use the following language to describe; full, empty, half full, nearly full and nearly empty.</p> <p>Order numbers from 0-50.</p> <p>One more and one less than numbers to 50.</p> <p>Compare numbers to 50, which is greater than or less than?</p>
History	<p>Find out about transport that was used in the past. E.g. tram, penny farthing, horse and cart. How is it different from the transport we use today?</p>
